<p>6</p>	<p>Allotment Provision</p> <p>Members discussed the land options available, the costs of providing allotments on those sites and the results of a Government survey which showed that the Council met the standard required.</p> <p>It was proposed by Councillor Reid and seconded by Councillor Stanger, that there was no further need for additional provision, based on the information provided.</p>
<p>7</p>	<p>Allotment Rent Period</p> <p>It was agreed that the yearly allotment rent period be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Changed to the 1 October with effect from 1 October 2024. 2. Officers write to allotment holders/Associations informing them of the change. 3. A discount of 10% be given if the rent invoices issued in April are paid together with the October amount.
<p>8</p>	<p>North Farm Play Area Fence</p> <p>Residents have approached the Ward County Councillor about their concerns that the play area does not have a perimeter fence and have witnessed safety concerns with children running across the road.</p> <p>The County Councillor is providing hard standings for additional parking to improve highway management and has offered to contribute £5k from her Members Local Improvement Fund should the Council install the necessary fencing. The fencing cost will be just under £25k.</p> <p>After discussion, Members agreed to install a perimeter fence and that the cost to the Council of £20k, be met from balances.</p> <p>Officers will seek further quotations for this work in accordance with Financial Regulations.</p>
<p>9</p>	<p>Delegated Actions Report</p> <p>Members noted the installation of Picnic Benches at Chestnut Avenue near the new Play Park.</p>
